8.	Scoobi	https://www.scoobi.co	\$2 to unlock \$.36 per minute after And \$.18 per minute while ride is paused.	A scoobi is an electric moped for rent. Locate the closest Scoobi to you by opening the mobile app. Please note: After you reserve the Scoobi, you have 10 minutes to get to the moped to start your ride. There is a designated zone where you are able to park free of charge.
